- Increased confidence in finding new ways to live life in a way congruent with what he/she values
- Provision of a safe person to discuss fears about their health decline
- Facilitate the development of a “Circle of Concern” – a supportive network of family, friends and providers to advocate for the individual
- Improved experience with the healthcare system by effectively aligning treatment options and type of care with quality of life goals and values.
