FAQs about On Site for Seniors:

What is On Site doing now? *On Site for Seniors (OSFS) is a nonprofit that continues meeting the medical, physical, and spiritual needs of homebound seniors and disabled adults in our community.*

What services are available? *There are four main service areas:*

- Our **Care Connect service** offers wound care, memory care, and primary care house call services for homebound adults using a “hybrid practice” design. Some visits are made in person and others are done by secure text messaging and video visits. Patient memberships are available *for \$40/mo. for a minimum of three months.* Since OSFS provides standard medical care, Medicare and other insurances may cover some services, and the membership allows access to many non-covered services. (Patient assistance may be available.)
- **The ht²¹ Program** is designed to increase meaningful connections for frail seniors, improving quality of life by strengthening *valued relationships*. Training is available for friends, facility staff and caregivers to learn how to engage adults in meaningful music, strategic play and reminiscence.
- **Spiritual Support:** Often seniors find encouragement from having someone help them process spiritual or emotional thoughts. Trained volunteers are available to listen and assist with prayer or Bible reading, discussing spiritual or faith concerns, forgiveness and relationship reconciliation, and meaning in life.
- **Your Path** is a wellness partnership that matches trained volunteers with frail elders who could benefit from a personal ‘guide’ that helps them navigate the healthcare system and to identify and reach individual life goals. This program is designed to:
 - Increase confidence in living life according to what matters most
 - Provide a listening ‘ear’
 - Identify and develop a support network
 - Initiate the creation of a *‘Personal Wellness Record’* that contains: medical information, person-centered values and preferences, and ‘story’ building for improving quality of life and meaningful relationships
 - Encourage a lasting hope through difficult life transitions.
